Whereas, in 2014 the deed books were re-filmed and scanned to be made viewable on-line and available for purchase, and


Whereas, John was responsible for having the plat images restored and implementing the new computer system, Kofile in 2017, and


Whereas, beginning in February 2019 credit cards were accepted in the office followed by accepting E- Recordings in April of 2019, and


