The Tuscola County Drain Commissioner will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the Fulton Street Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced.

The Fulton Street Drain will be let in 1 section as follows, each section having the length, average depth and width as set forth:

Said Drain is approximately 3,991 feet in length and is composed of approximately 2,380 feet of open drain and 1,611 feet of tile drain. Said open drain to have a 7-foot wide bottom on the lower end narrowing to a 4-foot wide bottom on the upper end, with 2 horizontal to 1 vertical side slopes, and an average depth of 5 feet. All stations are 100 feet apart. This Notice of Letting, the plans, specifications, and bid proposal shall be considered a part of the contract. A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on **Thursday, July 7, 2016 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Tuscola County Drain Commissioner's Office, 125 W. Lincoln Street, Suite 100, Caro, Michigan 48723. It is a requirement that any prospective General Contractor bidding attend this meeting. Representatives of the

Owner and Professional will be present to discuss the project. Attendance is required for sealed bids to be accepted. The Professional will transmit to all prospective bidders of record an Addendum as the Professional considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be legally effective.

A security deposit of five (5%) percent in the form of a cashier's check, money order, certified check or bidders bond shall be submitted with any bids. Checks shall be made payable to the Fulton Street Drain Drainage District. No cash will be permitted. The security deposits of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the Contract is awarded.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting.

If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

The Tuscola County Drain Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Apportionments on the above date, time and location. The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage District.

The Drain Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's determination of apportionments to the Tuscola County Probate Court within ten (10) days after the Day of Review.


