Note: If approved, this millage would result in an increase of 1.6163 mills for county services (\$1.61 per \$1,000 of taxable value).

The county's current allocated millage is 3.9417. Of the 2.7 mills requested, 1.6163 is the actual increase for county services, .8867 replaces the currently levied special purpose road patrol millage and .1970 replaces the currently levied special purpose senior citizens millage.
