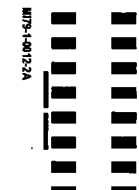

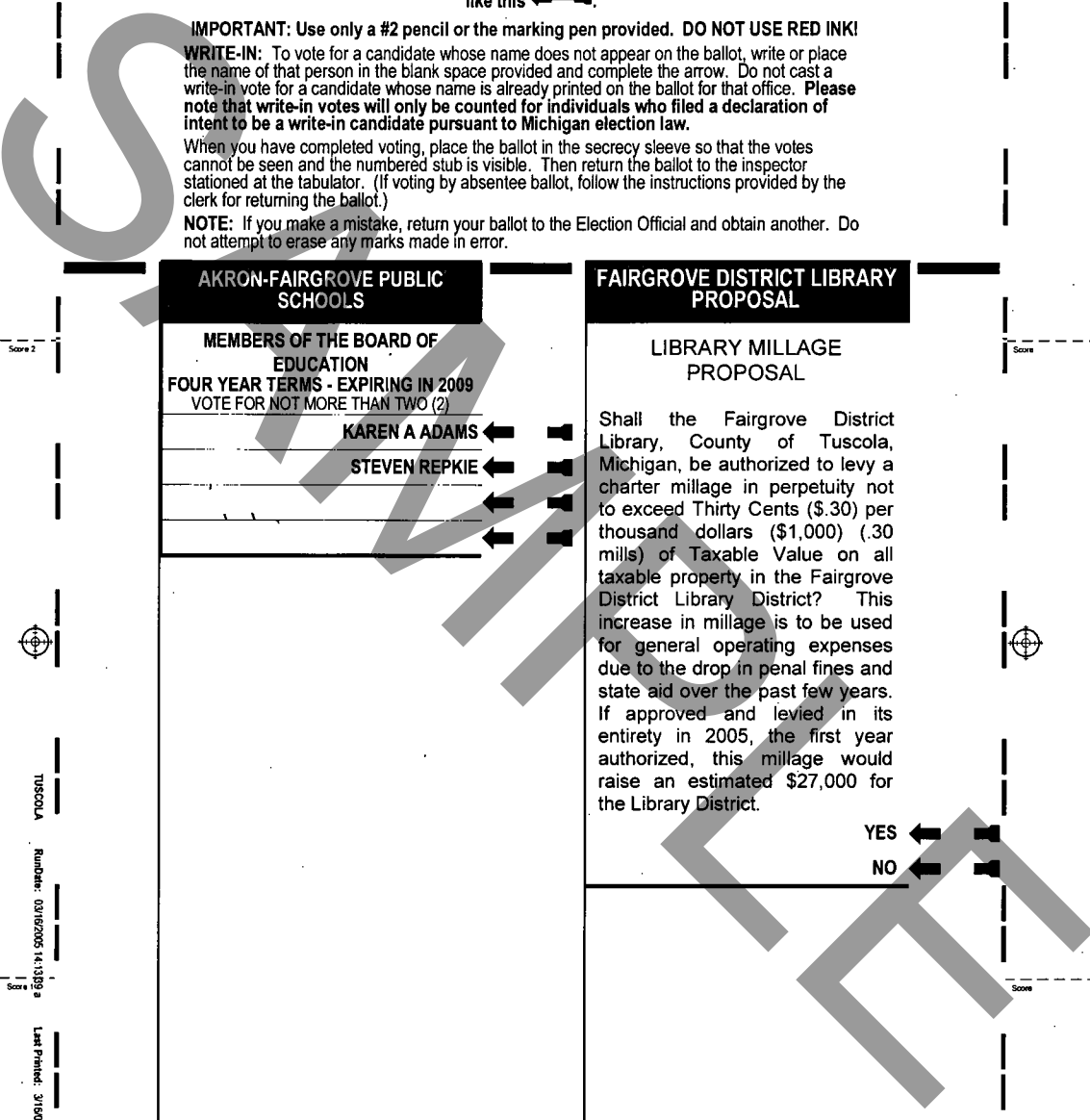

Bonding Proposal

Shall Caro Community Schools, Tuscola County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Fourteen Million Eight Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$14,860,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds in one or more series therefor, for the purpose of:

Partially remodeling furnishing and refurbishing, equipping and re-equipping McComb and Schall Elementary Schools. Caro Middle School and Caro High School; erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to the middle school; acquiring, installing and equipping technology for school facilities; and developing and improving sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The maximum numbers of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, will not exceed twenty (20) years. The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2005 is 3.14 mills (\$3.14 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a net increase of 1.93 mills (\$1.93 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.00 mills (\$2.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).
