



This proposal will enable the school district to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property except principal residence, qualified agricultural property and qualified forest property required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, exempting therefrom principal residence, qualified agricultural property and qualified forest property, as defined by law, in Kingston Community School, Tuscola and Lapeer Counties, Michigan, be increased by 2 mills (\$2.00 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2007 to 2011, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2007 is approximately \$15,154 (this millage is to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan
