

What we recycle at Tuscola County Recycle Facility...

- All paper products including newspapers, inserts, junk mail, phone books, office, school and computer paper
- #1 & #2 plastic bottles and jugs with screw tops (remove lids rinse out) NO butter tubs, yogurt cups, food trays, bags, etc.
- Clear glass bottles and jars (remove lids and rinse) Please NO Colored glass, light bulbs, window glass, or drinking glasses
- #6 polystyrene—clean egg cartons, cups, plates, packing peanuts
- Corrugated cardboard and boxboard
- Magazines and catalogs
- All types of metals- steel and aluminum (rinse out cans)
- Household batteries including rechargeable batteries & auto batteries
- Electronics: TVs, monitors, (call about fees) all-in-ones, computer towers, stereos, microwaves, VCRs, DVD players
- Rubber covered cords- extension cords, computer cords, etc.
- Ink jet cartridges
- Cell phones
- Motor oil (cannot be mixed with anything)
- Antifreeze (cannot be mixed with anything)
- Tires—a fee will be charged for all tires (a proof of residency is required)
*Limit seven tires at a time *Please call ahead
- Vinyl siding- remove all nails, wood and Styrofoam insulation
- Salvation Army bins to collect usable clothing, shoes and blankets
- Latex paint (fee), herbicides, pesticides collected year round (please call ahead)
- Plant containers #2, #5, #6 please remove all dirt and plant material

Tuscola County Recycling 2016 Millage Renewal

For a period of eight (8) years, from 2017 and continuing through 2024, inclusive, shall the expiring previously voted increase in the taxable property rate limitation of Tuscola County be renewed at the rate of .15 mills (\$.15 for each \$1,000 of taxable value) to provide funds for recycling within Tuscola County? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage raises an estimated \$262,000 in the first calendar year after its approval. All revenue will be disbursed to Tuscola County and shall be exclusively used for recycling activities within Tuscola County.
