The Tuscola County Drain Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Drainage District Boundaries on the above date, time and location. The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the Yax North Drain Drainage District boundaries. A map of the proposed Drainage District boundary revisions as recommended by a licensed professional engineer or surveyor is included with this Notice.

The Drain Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Tuscola County Circuit Court within ten (10) days.

Section two is a 12-inch diameter tiled drain approximately 300 feet in length with and average depth 4 feet. No cash will be permitted. The security deposits of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the Contract is awarded.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 a.m. on August 10, 2017, at the office of Spicer Group, Inc., 230 S. Washington Ave., Saginaw, MI 48607. It is a requirement that any prospective General Contractor bidding attend this meeting. Representatives of the Owner and Professional will be present to discuss the project. Attendance is required for sealed bids to be accepted. The Professional will transmit to all prospective bidders of record an Addendum as the Professional considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be legally effective.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

The Drain Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS about the Day of Review of Drainage District Boundaries, Notice of Letting and Day of Review of Apportionments

Why did I receive this notice?

In January 2016, the Village of Reese filed a petition for maintenance and improvement of the Yax North Drain to alleviate flooding issues. After a 3-member Board of Determination determined maintenance and improvement was necessary in March 2016, the Drain Commissioner developed a project.

All property owners in the Yax North Drain Drainage District subject to an assessment for the work performed were sent a copy of the notice.

What is a Day of Review of District Boundaries?

The Michigan Legislature passed a law in 2013 to allow revisions to historical drainage district boundaries for costs of construction or maintenance. when recommended by a licensed engineer.

What is a Drainage District?

A drainage district is the land area that benefits from the drain. The drainage district makes up the watershed that contributes water to the drain. Each property and municipality within the drainage district pays for maintenance and improvement of the drain.

Why are the boundaries being revised?

Revisions are recommended because the historic drainage district boundaries do not accurately reflect the current watershed of the drain.

What is a Lettina?

A drain contract letting is a public meeting where the

Drain Commissioner receives and opens bids from contractors to perform certain work on a Drain. Once a bid is selected, the project can begin.

What type of work will be performed?

The drain project will include the relocation of a storm sewer outlet, an upgrade of the existing storm sewer infrastructure and erosion control measures.

What is a Day of Review of Apportionments?

A Day of Review of Apportionments provides an opportunity for property owners to review the percent of benefit of the drain assigned to their property. The apportionments of benefit are based on acreage, land use, and other factors. The apportionments determine the assessment amount for each property

Why are the apportionments being revised?

Property owners can review changes with the Drain Parcel apportionments are being revised to more accurately reflect the percentage of benefit that each property receives from the drain. If a parcel is on the outer boundary of a drainage district, it is possible that only a portion of the parcel will be assessed.

When do I receive my drain assessment?

Drain assessments are included on your Winter Tax bill, and are only levied when costs are incurred for the drain. Assessment amounts vary from year to year.

What is my assessment amount?

Estimated assessment amounts are available at the Day of Review of Apportionments. If you are unable to attend, you may call (989) 672-3820 if you have any auestions.

Do I have to attend the Letting or Day of Review? You are not required to attend the Letting or Day of Review.
